Fatspatrol (Fathima Mohiuddin) is a multidisciplinary artist born and based in the UAE of Indian origin.

Making art from a true 3rd culture perspective, her work speaks in a culturally ambiguous voice prioritizing a humanist sensibility.

Passionate about public art and the role creativity plays in hope and humanity, she wrote her MA sociology thesis on the value of art in public spaces. She has gone on to be recognized globally as one of the first women street artists to emerge from the region.

Working in several mediums including drawing, painting, digital art, large scale murals and recently installation art, her most recent body of work 'The Humans' tells personal stories with universal notes viewing the world through a lens of poetic curiosity and wonder.

Her interest in mark-making, mythology and our innate inclination to create prioritize creativity as an integral aspect of human existence and our societies. Outside of commercial project and commissions, Fatspatrol has painted street art festivals in 10 countries, mentors emerging artists, works on outreach projects with youth and challenged communities and has curated urban art projects in the UAE over 10 years. Some early influences include comic books, textiles and Indian folk and tribal art.

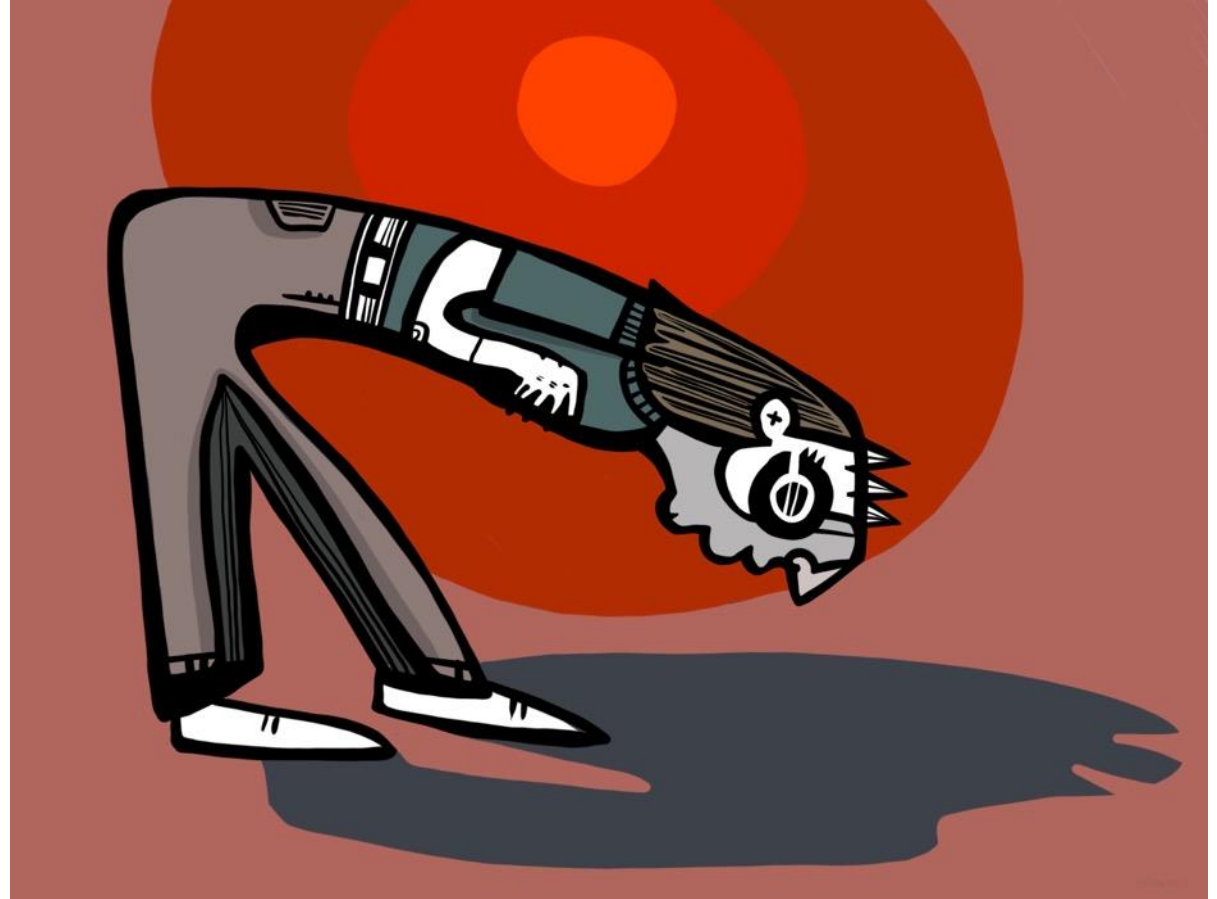

Between 2011 and 2023 she also founded and ran [The Domino](#), the UAE's first artist-led urban art agency.

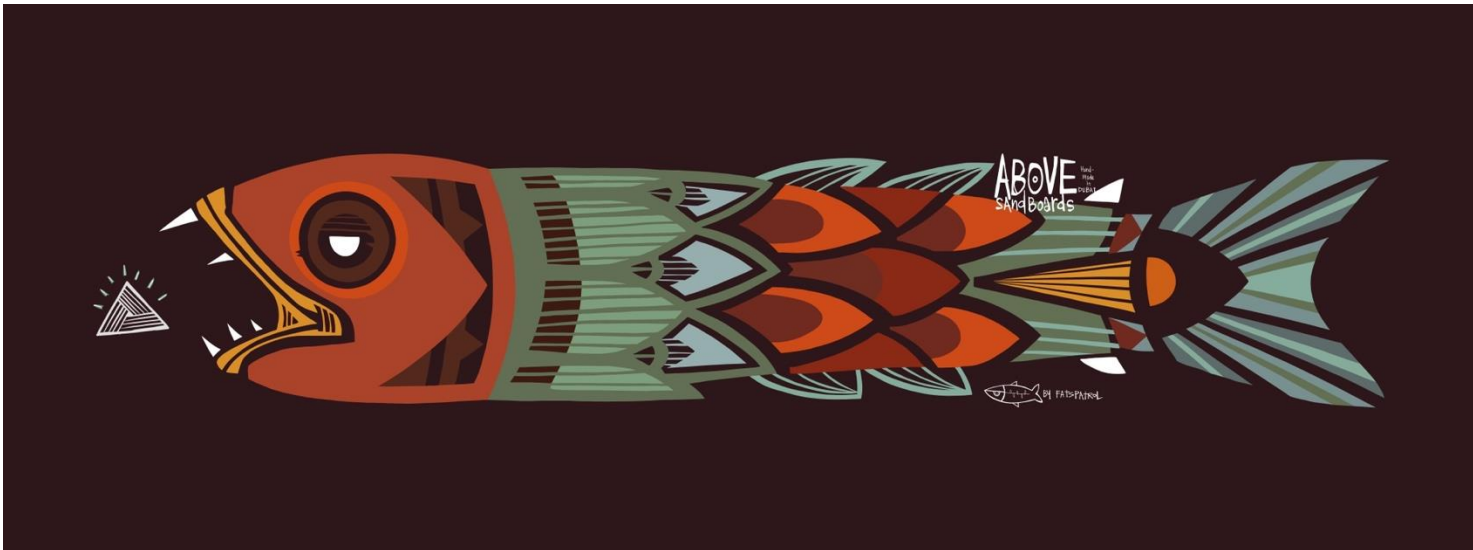
OUTREACH
